SUSTAINABLE INVESTING

WHAT IS INVESTING?

Allocating resources, usually money, with the expectation of generating an income or profit

WHAT IS SUSTAINABLE INVESTING?

Investing in companies that demonstrate responsible social, environmental, and ethical business practices that have positive impacts.

WHY SHOULD YOU INVEST SUSTAINABLY?

To grow your money while supporting companies with clean goals. Plus, companies with strong sustainability profiles may be better positioned for future challenges and experience fewer instances of bribery, corruption, and fruad.





TERMS & DEFINITIONS

<u>SUSTAINABILITY</u>: Focuses on meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs

INVESTING: The act of allocating resources, usually money, with the expectation of generating an income or profit

EXCHANGE TRADED FUND (ETF): A basket of securities you buy or sell through a brokerage firm on a stock exchange

INVESTMENT FIRM: A financial corporation that manages investments

<u>DIVIDEND</u>: Distribution of a company's earnings to a class of its shareholders that are paid out as cash or in the form of additional stock, usually quarterly

HOW TO INVEST SUSTAINABLY

Research & Explore Where You Want To Invest

- ightarrow Search for compainies/brands that you like
- Search company websites to find their annual sustainability report
- ightarrow Look up their investor relations
- ightarrow Use ESG rating tools to evaluate companies you want to invest in
- Create a list of companies with sustainable values that you would be willing to invest in

Set Up Your Investment Accounts

- \rightarrow Determine who you want to manage your investments
- Third party investment firms offer options to let you invest your own money, or let them invest it for you
- ightarrow Decide how much you want to start investing, you can begin with just \$1
- ightarrow Open your investment accounts

<u>Start Investing</u>

- ightarrow Make your first investment
- Follow your investment's performance and buy or sell at your descretion
- To make a return on your investment, you must sell it for more than you paid for it


